**CONSERVATION COMMISSION MEETING**

**July 14, 2026**

The meeting was called to order at 630PM, opening with the Pledge of Allegiance.

The minutes of the June 9 meeting were read and accepted by Sheila Lawrence and seconded by Lisa Gardner. All were in favor.

A report was presented for review regarding water projects. It has been determined that the State of Vermont along with the federal government provides significant grant monies to develop public water systems to rural towns in Vermont and that the town would certainly be eligible to participate in these grants. Further action will be to investigate costs, speak with the agencies and deliver results to the Board of Selectmen concerning this project. Next steps to be to invite the people at the state level to attend a meeting for additional information once the town's interest in participation is indicated.
