BENNINGTON COUNTY SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT

Mike Denault will contact the department to review these matters and request a new contract since the current contract expires January 31, 2022.

Ryan Wolters has not responded to the town's letter requesting proof of liability insurance coverage in accordance with his agreement with the town to plow the Class 4 section of the town road. Mike Denault will contact Mr. Wolters.

BUDGET WORK SESSION

The Selectboard reviewed the town and highway revenue sheets. The next budget work session will be the first part of the January 6, 2022 meeting.
